- County adopted new Math Project on-line.

III. President's Report:

- We already had 2 big events: beautification of school grounds, ice cream social.
- PTA is starting 7 new programs; they are budgeted for the fall.
- Online registration for programs will start next week, likely on Wednesday; the delay of registration is due to the county process of assigning space.
- As voted by PTA last year, we continue support for a track project, which is a gift from the PTA.
- Last year we did really well with fundraising, so we give \$10K check to school.
- PTA eliminated some fundraising projects like Sally Foster.
- PTA biggest fundraising program this year is Sunshine 5K & Fun Run. We would like to encourage everybody to participate.
- PTA uses donations to support after school programs and events: we support PTA activities and try to keep our programs at break even.
- Last year the Bylaws were revised; they are posted online for review and comments for 30 days. The Bylaws will be on vote the next PTA meeting.
- Next PTA event: Wednesday, September 19th is 5% day at the Vienna Whole Foods Market. 5% of sales is donated to Louise Archer ES, school principal is in the Whole Foods Market from noon to 1 pm. No code is necessary at the checkout.

- All PTA program info is on the website, including info for program chairs; PTA is paperless.
