Call to order at 9:34 am

Welcome!

Principal's Report:

- Welcome, we have 650 students this year. We've already had back to school night which was earlier this year. Parents should be getting a monthly update from teachers and every other week the school send a news you choose email
- New things Jill Gallagher had her baby yesterday, and Claire Sefein also delivered today. Barbara Jefferson will be our long term substitute
- Salad bar is coming. It will start Sept 26th. The school will send a video, and the children will take a training on how to walk through. The cafeteria has changed to accommodate the new salad bar. Students will walk through the salad line first. A letter will go home, with an explanation of how the menu changes with a salad bar
- Laptops 5th and 6th grade students will all have laptops this year. This should save on instructional time by saving on logins and enhance learning, looking to provide to all 4th graders as well on day.

Assistant Principal's Report:

- Crisis drills we've had 1 every week so far (3 fire drills, and 1 lockdown). With 1 lockdown planned for next week. And 2 more lockdowns throughout the year. The school reiterates that the drills are for safety and knowing safe places and do not elaborate on the types of danger.

Treasurer's Report:

2018-2019 Budget

- Changed the format this year, grouping the line items so you can see the net.
- 6th grade event was reclassified to a community event from fundraiser, since the intent is not to raise money
- Community events are break even

- Note about before and after school programs. This program has a revenue and payment timing issue. We bring in revenue in one year, and pay bills in the following year. This is not a revenue generating program, but if participation increases it looks like revenue generating because the higher bills are paid the following year.
- The target for the cash reserve is \$30k, we are currently at \$40k, so will be doing more outreach to make sure the budgets are spent and that teachers take advantage of the PTA programs.

- Audit looks good for last year. Minor suggestions, PTA needs to spend more money, only thing needed in reserve is enough to cover bills for the summer
- Try to make sure money is spent that benefits the community
- Looking for a new Audit chair for next year, committee typically meets in July
